Development of formal and informal civic education in the area of pre-medical training of citizens in the territory of Dnipropetrovsk region.

1. Problem definition

In the conditions of the unjustified aggression of the Russian Federation, the level of danger throughout the territory of Ukraine, both in the zone of active hostilities and in the territory where hostilities are not carried out, is extremely high. In these conditions, the problem of lack of knowledge on providing pre-medical care to the injured is acute. And the inability to react properly and provide help before the arrival of the medical team very often costs the lives of Ukrainians. Currently, the Dnipropetrovsk region borders the areas of active hostilities. The maximum amount of organizational, technical, and humanitarian resources for cooperation and support of the front is concentrated here, and citizens lack elementary knowledge of pre-medical training in case of a critical situation. An analysis of mortality statistics shows that if at least 60% of the personnel of a military formation are able to provide first aid on the battlefield, 80-90% of the wounded have a chance to survive. The statistics of mortality as a result of emergency situations outside the limits of active hostilities show that out of 100 victims, 24 die in hospitals, and 76 - at the pre-hospital stage, of which 20% of deaths are related to receiving injuries incompatible with life, and the cause the other 80% is the imperfection of the system of providing pre-medical care to victims directly in the emergency zone. From the beginning of the full-scale invasion, in the period from February to August 2022, with the aim of partially improving the situation in the field of pre-medical training of citizens in the territory of the Dnipropetrovsk region, on the basis of the Dnipropetrovsk State University of Internal Affairs (DSUIA), specialists of the Department of Forensic Science and Pre-Medical Care conducted 200 trainings "Basic rules for providing first aid in combat conditions." More than 3,000 people from among representatives of internal affairs bodies, education workers and civilians have completed the training. However, the level of material and technical support for further training of citizens is insufficient, and some of the existing demonstration equipment is morally outdated or worn out and cannot perform its functions. In the current conditions, it is impossible to solve the problem by the efforts of the applicant or any other individual organization, because both the financial resources and the functional powers of each of them are insufficient. Taking into account the need for quick response and problem solving, the Dnipro Medical Cluster has initiated the unification of the efforts of the public sector, the Dnipropetrovsk Regional Military Administration, the DSUIA and the Joint Stock Company "National Public Television and Radio Company of Ukraine" to implement such a vital initiative as the development of civic education in pre-medical training of citizens in peacetime and in the conditions of hostilities, through the implementation of the joint project "Development of formal and informal civic education in the part of pre-medical training of citizens in the territory of Dnipropetrovsk region".

2. Purpose and tasks

Purpose: To promote the development of civic education, including formal and informal, in peacetime and combat conditions in terms of pre-medical training of citizens, by organizing the work of a training center for pre-medical training on the basis of the Dnipropetrovsk State University of Internal Affairs (Dnipro, Gagarin Ave.,26) until June 30, 2023.

Tasks: 1. To equip an educational and methodical center for pre-medical training of citizens on the basis of DSUIA (Dnipro, Gagarina Ave. 26) by the end of February 2023. 2. To ensure the compliance of the qualification level of 5 specialists in pre-medical training of citizens in the training and methodical center on the basis of DSUIA in the city of Dnipro in accordance with the Resolution of the Cabinet of Ministers of Ukraine dated November 21, 2012 No. 1115 "On approval of the Procedure for training and upgrading the qualifications of persons who are obliged to provide pre-medical care" by the end of February 2023.

3. To conduct training on pre-medical training of citizens at the training and methodical center on the basis of the DSUIA in the city of Dnipro for 5,000 students from the number of willing citizens and 400 people from the number of cadets of the department of criminology and pre-medical training of the DSUIA.

4. To conduct a large-scale communication campaign in the territory of Dnipropetrovsk region to inform citizens about the start, implementation and results of the project, ensuring interaction with the mass media and state authorities,

involving the information resources of the project partners, as well as with the aim of spreading the positive experience of organizing civil society organizations efforts to develop formal and non-formal education in the conditions caused by the aggression of the Russian Federation in the period from February 2023 to July 2023.

3. Expected results and benefits of the project

- Ensuring compliance with the requirements of the Procedure for Training and Advanced Training of Persons Who Are Obligated to Provide Pre-Medical Care, approved by Resolution No. 1115 of the Cabinet of Ministers of Ukraine Dated November 21, 2012.
- Increasing the level of awareness of the population about the free opportunity to improve knowledge and skills in providing pre-medical care.
- Ensuring the level of knowledge and skills of students to choose methods and means of saving life, in particular - to provide pre-medical assistance to victims of emergency situations in peacetime and combat conditions; carry out an assessment of the condition of victims in emergency situations of man-made and natural nature, as well as in combat conditions; the skills of stopping bleeding, first aid for various types of injuries, body burns, hypothermia, cardiac and respiratory arrest were formed.

4. Scope of works

1. Arrangement of an educational and methodical center for pre-medical training of citizens on the basis of the DSUIA in the city of Dnipro.
2. Increasing the qualification level of specialists in pre-medical training of citizens from the number of pedagogical workers of the State Medical Center, who will be involved in educational and training activities within the framework of the project.
3. Informing citizens about the start of the project.
4. Informing citizens about the schedule of educational and training events.
5. Conducting educational and training activities within the framework of project implementation.
6. Informing the public and partners about the results of the project implementation, sharing the positive experience of cooperation between the public sector and state authorities for the implementation of vital initiatives.

5. Project monitoring and evaluation

In order to monitor and evaluate the effectiveness of project measures, to eliminate possible risks and threats, a monitoring system has been developed, which includes:

- study of project documentation;
- checking the knowledge, abilities and skills of training participants;
surveying participants for the purpose of studying their attitude to the project, taking into account opinions about the need to improve activities within the framework of the project.

A system of project indicators has been developed: source, method, schedule, responsible.

6. Project period

The duration of the project is 7 months

7. Cost of the project

The estimated cost of the project is UAH 2,000,000
